

Matter is Not Real

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In 1950, Albert Einstein said the following: "Concerning matter, we have all been wrong. What we have called matter is energy. Whose vibration has been lowered as to be perceptible to the senses. There is no Matter." While considering that fact, here's what Dr. Laurance Doyle, Astro-physicist of NASA Ames Research Center https://www.nasa.gov/ames said relatively recently on the subject of time.

What we're measuring is Earth's orbit around the sun. Our year is really just one of the motions of a planetary body. Anytime matter repeats itself, we have a clock, whether it the hands of a clock going around or a planet around a sun.

Time is a finite concept. You need matter to have time. Matter being redundant is what time is. No one's ever found a relationship between Earth's orbit around the sun and the human body. This idea of aging just by how many times the Earth has revolved around the sun is scientifically irreverent. It's an educated belief. [Recall the age of those in the Old Testament.]

There have been many types of calendars such as time to plant or hunt. Originally it was helpful in creating order. In this archo-astronomy, it helped man find order beyond what just the senses say. For example, when the senses didn't say anything, the stars could say the Nile would flood tomorrow. Or when the growing season would begin. In this sense, the calendar overcame limits. Since then though, we've imposed them on our own abilities such as at 16 you can drive, at 80 you can't or something like that. It's become a limitation we need to outgrow. Time is just a relative motion of matter being redundant. In the same sense, the molecules of the body come and go. No molecules in the body are the same as 5 years ago. So how come you still look like you do? Your identity is maintained but it certainly is not the matter.

When you think of yourself as materially, it's very limiting. We are negligible in a material sense. But as a spiritual idea that's needed to complete the principle of the universe--- we are a spiritual idea needed to complete the infinite just as the number 7 is needed to hold mathematics in place. The bigger the universe gets, the more significant we become. So it's just the opposite, matter and spirituality. Completely negligible or completely irreplaceable.



In 1934, a famous theologian said "He [Jesus] laid the ax of Science at the root of material knowledge, that it might be ready to cut down the false doctrine of pantheism, - that God, or Life, is in or of matter."
